In the next five years, MADC aims to develop and operate about six new airports in Tier – II and Tier – III cities of Maharashtra. This will take the total number of operational airports to more than 15 in the state, thereby providing seamless connectivity to semi-urban population."

Additionally, MADC has planned to operationalise nine airports under Regional Connectivity Scheme, also named as UDAN, the dream project of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.

Mr. Kakani informed that Shirdi Airport is the fastest growing airport in India; the passenger handling capacity of the airport will double to 1.4 million in the coming years.

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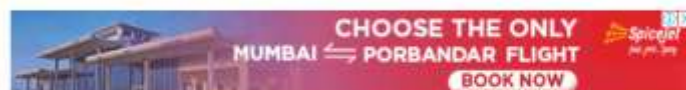
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Sri Lanka pavilion at World Trade Expo in Mumbai showcases popular Sri Lankan brands
