



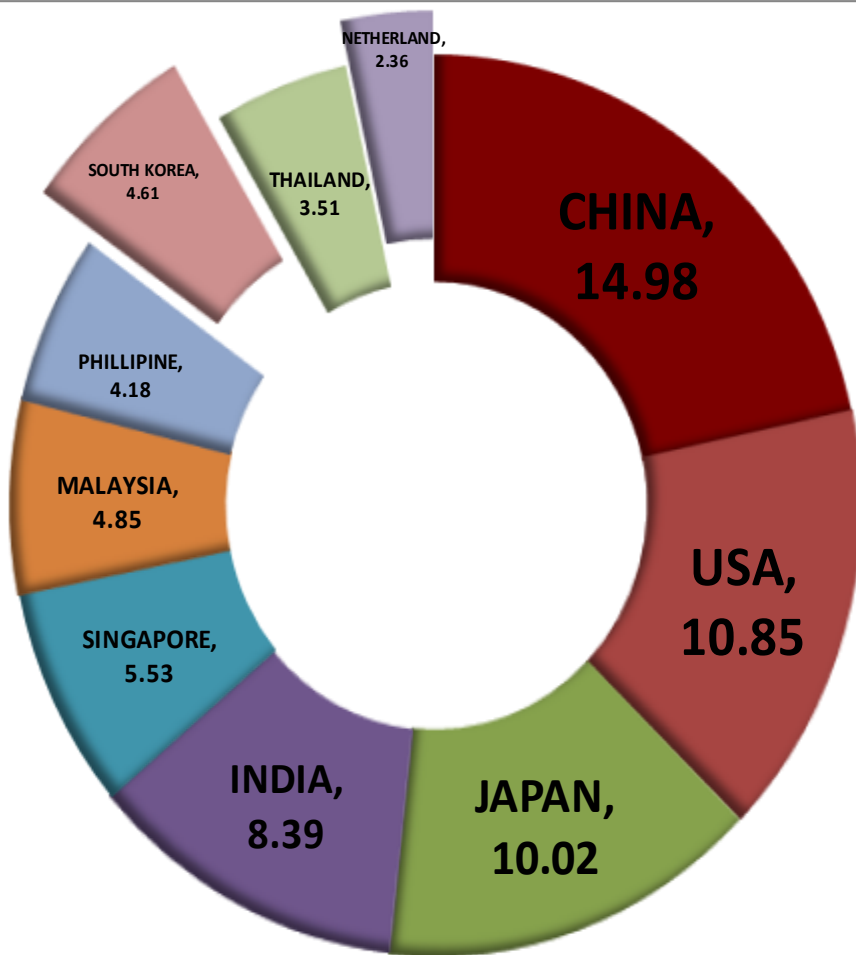

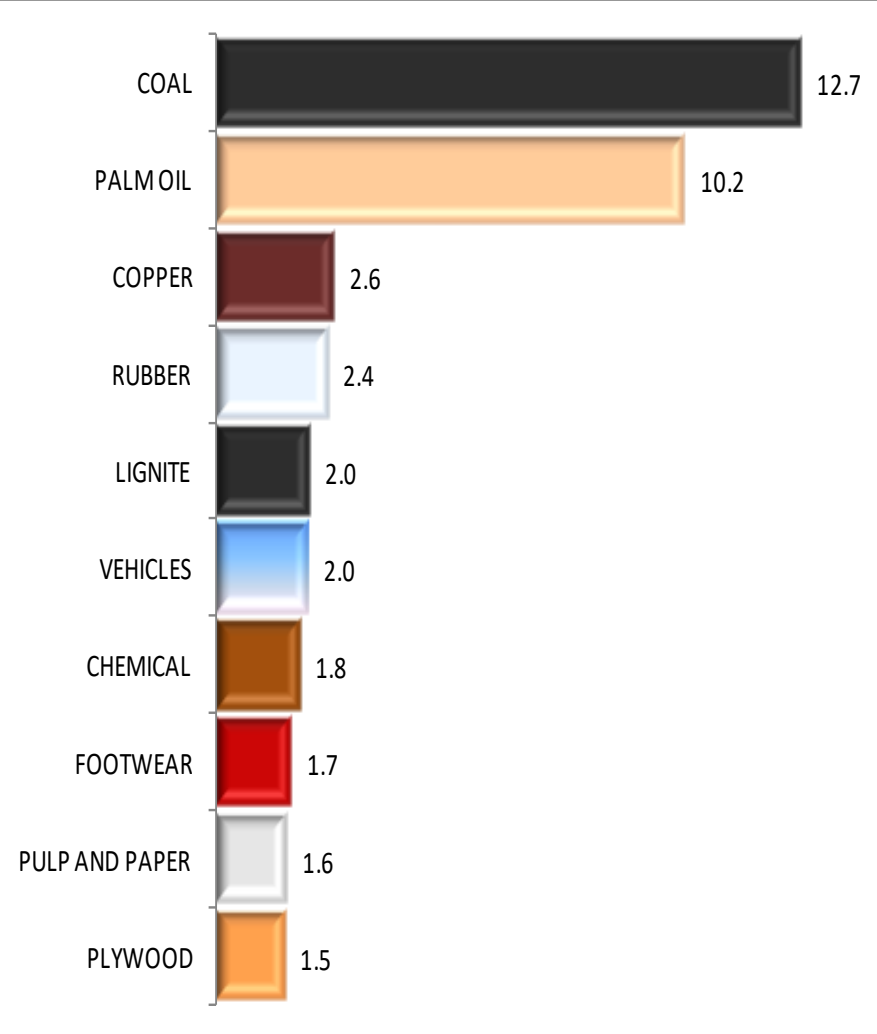

India is Indonesia's fourth largest trading partner after China, USA and Japan with 8.4 billion dollar. Indonesia's exports to still rely on primary commodities, such as: Coal, Palm oil, copper, rubber and lignite. Although, Indonesia also export vehicles, chemical, footwear, pulp and paper and plywood. 23 % of Indonesia's export dominated by Coal and Palm Oil.

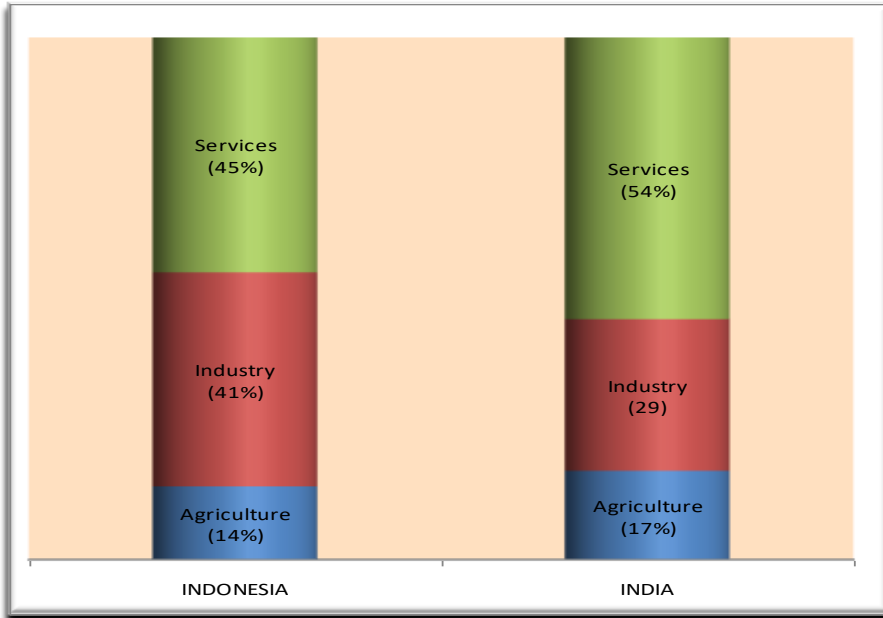

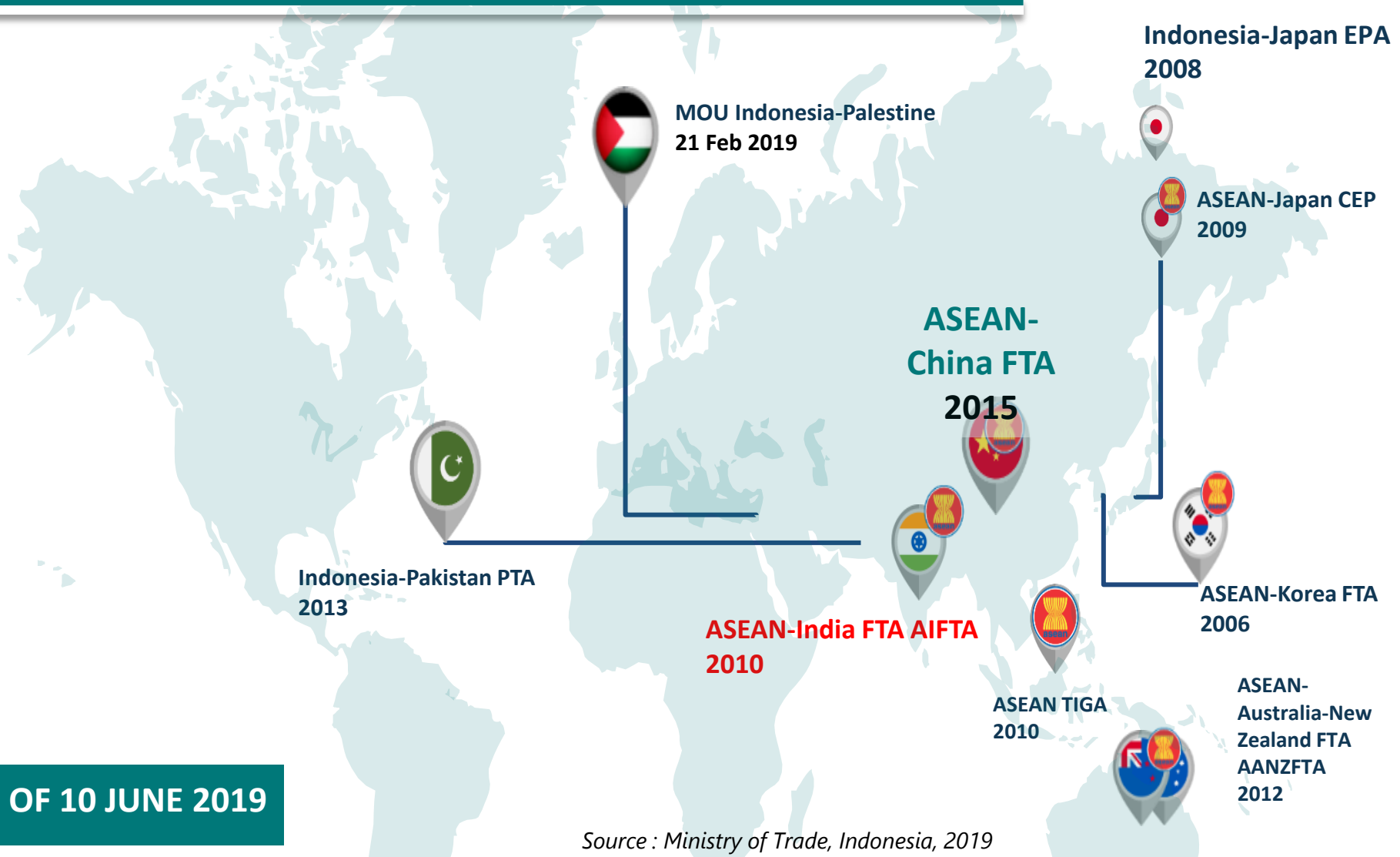

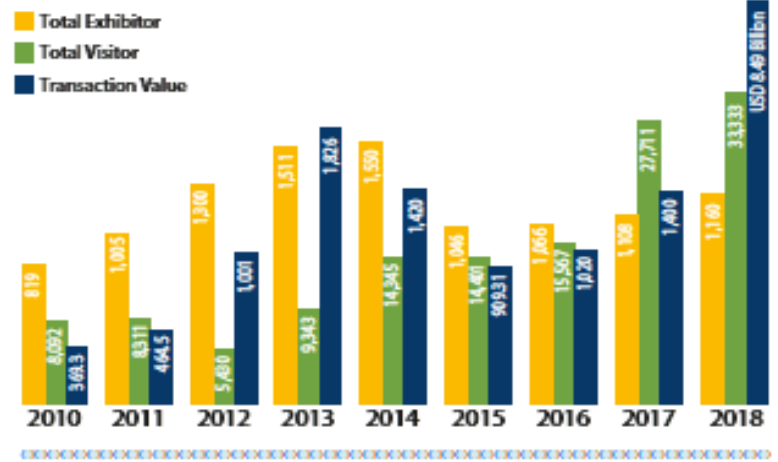

TOTAL TRANSACTION VALUE 2018

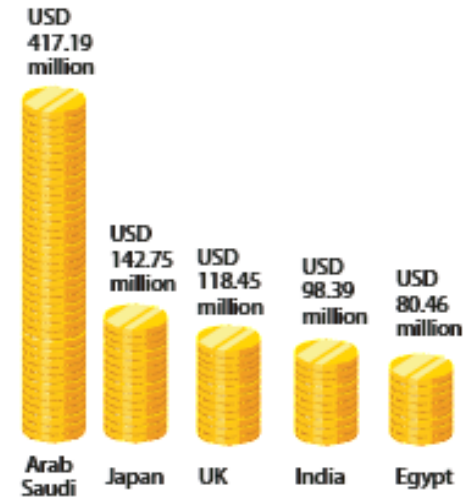

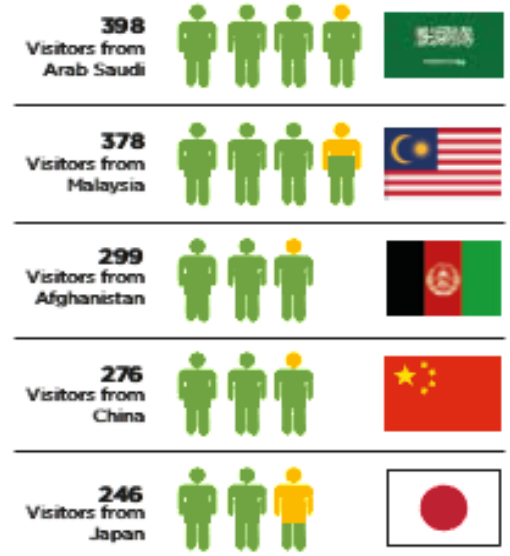
TOTAL VISITORS 2018
