

India's Exports to Republic of Korea with Growth Potential

India-Republic of Korea (RoK) relations have made great strides in recent years. Trade and economic relations have gathered momentum since the implementation of the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) in 2010.

Merchandise trade between the two nations stood at about USD 20.5 billion in FY 2019-20. However, India's exports to RoK were only about USD 4.8 billion. Given this backdrop, we have identified the following products as having growth potential in India's exports to RoK. These products constituted about 24 per cent of India's exports to RoK in 2019 and about six per cent of RoK's imports from the world.

With RoK's New Southern Policy and India's Act East Policy giving thrust to bilateral relations, and RoK's realignment of economic relations with India as a key partner in the Indo Pacific region, we hope our trade to RoK will gain further momentum in the years ahead.
