New and Expansion MSME Units are eligible for subsidy of 15% to 35% of fixed capital investment with limit varying from Rs.20 to 100 lacs (depending on location).



Capital Subsid

New and Expansion MSME Units are eligible for subsidy of Rs.2.00 per unit for the units located in Vidharbha, Marathwada and north Maharashtra and for the districts of Ratnagiri & Sindhudurg in Konkan region, and Rs.1.00 per unit for the units in other areas of the State for a period of 5 years from the date of production.



New and Expansion MSME Units are eligible for interest subsidy @ 5% per annuminterest paid to the banks and public financial institutions on the amount of term loans taken for acquisition of fixed assets.



Workforce Welfare Assistance



Eligible units are eligible for refund of EPF/ESI paid towards women employment up to 50% of contribution paid by the company for the period of 5 years.

Brand Development



The Government shall facilitate development of brand for Women Entrepreneurs in Micro & Small Enterprises for marketing their products. The assistance will be at 50% of cost of brand development limited to a maximum of Rs.1.00 Cr.

Assistance for participation in Exhibitions



To encourage participation in Exhibitions by providing assistance of 75% of stall rentals - limited to Rs 0.50 lac for domestic and Rs.3.00 lacs for international exhibitions. Assistance of up to 50% of cost incurred in organizing exhibition for women entrepreneur, limited to a maximum of Rs.10 lacs.



Incubation	A reservation of 30% space for women entrepreneurs shall be provided in Incubation Centres promoted by the State.
Awards	On the lines of IT awards, exceptional women-centric enterprises will be awarded every year.
Venture Fund	Women & Child Development Department will create a Rs.50 crore special venture fund for women entrepreneurs.
Skill Development	Training assistance of Rs.3000/- per women employee per year for the initial 3 years of the unit from the date of commencement of commercial production. The assistance will be linked to "Late Pramod Mahajan Skill Development Scheme".



Special Package Of Incentives

Additional fiscal benefits under Package Scheme of Incentive-2013

- ➤ Incentives of C zone will be applicable to industries located in A & B zones.
- ➤ Incentives of D+ zone will be applicable to industries located in C & D zones
- ➤ Incentives of Naxal Affected Areas will be applicable to industries located in D+ and No Industry District zones.

- ➤ Industrial Promotion Subsidy : GST Refund
- > Stamp Duty Exemption
- Electricity Duty Exemption
- ➤ Incentives for strengthening of MSMEs
