

## **INDIA-ASEAN Relations**

• India's Look East Policy has now matured into a dynamic and action oriented 'Act East Policy'.

• India has set up a separate Mission to ASEAN and the EAS (East Asia Summit) in Jakarta in April 2015 with a dedicated Ambassador to strengthen engagement with ASEAN and ASEAN-centric processes.

•India and ASEAN are observed 25 years of their Dialogue Partnership, 15 years of Summit Level interaction and 5 years of Strategic Partnership throughout 2017 by undertaking a wide range of activities, both in India and through Missions in ASEAN Member States, which would culminate in a Commemorative Summit on the theme "Shared Values, Common Destiny."

# INDIA-ASEAN Relations (Contd.)

- ASEAN Multilateral Division offers project-based financial assistance to ASEAN countries. Financial assistance has been provided to ASEAN countries from the following Funds: ASEAN-India Cooperation Fund, ASEAN-India S&T Development Fund (AISTDF), ASEAN-India Green Fund, & ASEAN-India Projects.
- India has an annual Track 1.5 event Delhi Dialogue, for discussing politicosecurity and economic issues between ASEAN and India.
- Set up in 2013, the AIC (ASEAN-India Centre) has been serving as a resource centre for ASEAN Member States and India, for strengthening ASEAN-India strategic partnership and promoting India-ASEAN dialogue and cooperation in the areas of mutual interests.



# PHILIPPINES is the fastest expanding economy of ASEAN

- The Philippines is the fastest-expanding major ASEAN economy in 2016. The IMF expects the Philippines to maintain a similar GDP growth in 2017 on the back of a series of continued demands and modest fiscal stimulus programs supported by the local government. Backed with US\$50 billion of revenue from remittances and outsourcing which represents approximately, 9.8% of GDP in 2016, was definitely, a major driver of private consumption in the Philippines economy!
- Since 2012, the government has implemented new Industrial policies that aimed to improve the country's industrial competitiveness with a business savvy environment. Now seen as a new growth area, the Philippines is well positioned to attract new investment & suppliers that would catalyse industry growth and development.
- According to World Bank & Asian Development Bank, "The Philippines will continue to be the fastestgrowing economy in the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) in 2018."
