




11 projects were implemented in the amount of 70 million US dollars

Domestic pharmaceutical production in 2019 increased by 3 times in financial and 4 times in quantitative terms compared with 2014.


The number of manufacturers increased by more than 30% compared to 2014.


EXPECTED GROWTH IN THE PHARMACEUTICAL INDUSTRY

Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. DP-4554 dated 12/30/2019 "About additional measures for deepening reforms in the pharmaceutical industry of the Republic of Uzbekistan"

"Reducing imports of medicines through modernization, increasing existing production capacities and the development of new types of medicines, as well as by attracting investments".

Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. DP-5707 dated 04/10/2019 "On further measures to accelerate the development of the pharmaceutical industry of the republic in 2019 - 2021" "When making state purchases of medicines and medical supplies, the state customer rejects all applications containing proposals for the supply of imported medicines and medical supplies, if there are two or more participants - domestic producers of similar products".

The Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. LRU-598 dated 25/12/2019, "On Investments and Investment Activities"



Filing an application by Investor

Consideration of the possibility of implementing the project, transfer of the application to the Administrative Council of the FEZ (in 2 working days)

Making the decision to place an investment project by FEZ Governing Body (in 5 working days)

Granting the status of a FEZ participant by Directorate of FEZ (in 1 working day)

- 2. Business-plan,
- 3. Information about investors working experience,
- 4. Information on the financial and economic activities of the investor.








