

GSEF PRESIDENT ATTENDS GES 2025 IN MUMBAI

Abdul Dewale Mohammed (ADM), Group Executive President of the Global South Economic Forum (GSEF) and founder of the emerging Global South Chambers of Commerce, Industry, Mines, and Agriculture (GOSCCIMA) and the Global South Engineers Association (GSEA), will participate in the 10th Global Economic Summit (GES) 2025 and 6th World Trade Expo (WTE), taking place on 21–22 November 2025 at the World Trade Centre Mumbai, India.
